

Leaf WAND

Make your very own wand decorated with beautiful coloured leaves, feathers or fallen petals.



HRH The Duchess of Cambridge and the RHS have created a series of activity cards to inspire families to have fun, play together and engage with nature.



Find your materials

Nature is full of beautiful colours and shapes. Head out to your local park or wood and see if you can find different leaves that have fallen from the trees, feathers left by birds or petals that have fallen from nearby flowers – be careful not to pick them from the plants! Pop your chosen materials in a bag to take home.

Equipment needed

- ❑ Fallen leaves and petals in your chosen colours and any other natural objects you find that might add to your wand.
- ❑ A long stick
- ❑ Scissors
- ❑ Double-sided tape or glue



Let's make your wand!

1. Find a long stick and lay your chosen leaves and other materials out. Have a think about where they might go along your wand.
2. Stick a strip of double-sided tape or spread some glue along the outside of your stick.
3. Apply your leaves and chosen materials around the wand and leave to dry.
4. Your wand is now ready!
